P: If I learn, I'll (I will) pass the exam.

N: If I learn, I won't fail the exam.

Typ II – unwahrscheinliche Bedingung (Traum)

if + Simple Past, Conditional I (= would + Nennform)

P: If I learnt, I would pass the exam.

N: If I learnt, I wouldn't fail the exam.

N: If I didn't learn, I wouldn't pass the exam.
