Typ I – wahrscheinliche Bedingung

if im Simple Present + will-Future (Nennform)

P: If I **learn**, I **will** pass the exam.

N: If I **learn**, I **won't fail** the exam.

N: If I **don't learn**, I **will fail** the exam.

N: If I **don't learn**, I **won't pass** the exam.

Typ II – unwahrscheinliche Bedingung (Traum)

if + Simple Past, Conditional I (= would + Nennform)

P: If I **learnt**, I **would pass** the exam.

N: If I **learnt**, I **wouldn't fail** the exam.

N: If I **didn't learn**, I **would fail** the exam.

N: If I **didn't learn**, I **wouldn't pass** the exam.

Typ III – Bedingung nicht mehr erfüllbar (zu spät)

if + Past Perfect, Conditional II (= would + have + Past Participle)

P: If I **had learnt**, I **would have passed** the exam.

N: If I **had learnt**, I **wouldn't have failed** the exam.

N: If I **hadn't learnt**, I **would have failed** the exam.

N: If I **hadn't learnt**, I **wouldn't have passed** the exam.

would kann ersetzt werden durch **could** oder **might**

(should, may oder must sind zum Teil auch möglich)
